Aims:

- To continue the determination of the distribution, abundance and condition of scallops off the south Devonshire and Cornish coast, commencing at Lizard Point and working eastwards.
- To carry out comparative trials between a Baird dredge and a 2. conventional scallop dredge on the Eddystone scallop grounds.
- To release measured and tagged scallops over a wide area between 3. Fowey and Rame Head for population and growth studies.
- 4. To continue the search for O+ to 2+ group scallops on the commercial grounds with weed rakes and lined dredges fitted with blade

Narrative:

Because of bad weather TELLINA did not leave Lowestoft until 22 February, and then was weather-bound again at Felixstowe and Ipswich. The wind moderated on 5 March and TELLINA steamed as far as Dover before being weather-bound once more. An extension of the cruise until 23 March was obtained but, with the forecast of more bad weather to come, the cruise was cancelled on 15 March. TELLINA finally berthed at Lowestoft on 16 March.
