- 1. 2m Bean trawl survey for 0-group flatfish.
- 2. Otter trawl survey for large flatfish and tagging of adult sole.
- 3. 12" Tin Tow net survey for pelagic eggs and larvae.
- 4. Release of seabed and surface drifters.
- 5. Collection of small cod and other fish for experimental use (Mr. Garrod and Dr. Walker).

Narrative

Work was possible only on 19 September due to southeast < south force 7 and 8 winds.

Results

- 1. The ten standard 2m Beam trawl tows were completed. Catches of 0-group sole were larger than in the same month last year: catches of dabs and plaice were smaller.
 - 2. Live fish were brought back to the laboratory for experimental uso.
- 3. Surface and seabed drifters were released on the three stations at Sizewell Bank (inside, on and outside the bank).
